Preoperative surgical instructions:

Your arrival time will be texted or called to you two business days before your surgery

Nothing to eat (including gum, candy or tobacco products) and nothing to drink 8 hours prior to your arrival time.

You can take your morning medicines with a sip of water except diabetes medicines

Do not take any diabetic medications the morning of surgery

Bring your ID, insurance card and any copay required

You must have someone to drive you home from the surgery center and care for you...no taxi, UBER or other driving services allowed

Please ensure you pick up your surgery eye drops (except Dr. Weaver's and Dr. Kato's patients that do not get eye drops) which should already be called in to your pharmacy. If not, please contact Eye Associates at 878-6161 so they can fax in your prescription. Bring these eye drops with you to the surgery center

If you have antibiotic eye drops prescribed (moxifloxacin, vigamox, ciprofloxacin, besivance, polytrim, or polymixin), you should take one drop four times a day on the day before surgery and one drop the morning of surgery

Wear loose fitting clothes and a short sleeved shirt

No jewelry or contact lenses should be worn the day of surgery

No make up the day of surgery and please remove any mascara the morning of surgery

If this is your first surgery, please bring the green medical history form filled out on front and back

If this is your second cataract surgery please bring your blue bag and dark glasses
